SoS! School Supply Drive

Each year, the Long Island Coalition for the Homeless collects new backpacks and school supplies for homeless and at-risk children throughout Nassau and Suffolk Counties. Through partnerships with local government, libraries, schools, local and corporate business, sports clubs, non-profits and other community partners, we host the SoS! School Supply Drive from May to August.

The preparation for distribution begins in August, with Sort & Pack volunteer events throughout the month. The backpack distribution begins each year at the **Back Pack Pirates Festival** at the end of August.

Last year, the Long Island Coalition for the Homeless was able to distribute 2,500 backpacks to homeless and at-risk children.

Back Pack Pirates Festival

The Back Pack Pirates Festival is a pirate-themed summer camp event for homeless children and children in foster care programs on Long Island. The Long Island Coalition for the Homeless provides a full day of recreational and education activities at the summer camp for almost 500 children. Over the years, activities have expanded to include face painting, beach time, arts & crafts, a treasure hunt, various sports and sprinkler time.

Each child receives breakfast, lunch, healthy snacks and drinks, new, ageappropriate backpacks filled with school supplies, new bathing suits and towels (many of the children do not have bathing suits and their families cannot risk sending them to camp with one of the family's few bath towels), and new back to school clothing.

Ideas for conducting drives in your community

One Day Drives at Stores, Etc.

- □ Contact your local libraries, supermarkets, shopping centers or malls and request permission to have a drive there on a designated day. (sample letter is provided)
- □ Hang fliers announcing the drive, and what you will be collecting.
- On the day of the drive, be sure to hang fliers or other information about the drive, Long Island's homeless, and the need for the items you are collecting. A shopping list is included in your kit. You can modify this to show only those items you would like to collect, and hand it out to shoppers before they enter the store. We can provide you with these materials upon request.
- □ Have members of your group/team/club take shifts, depending on the length of the drive.
- ☐ Make sure you have a way of collecting and transporting the items you receive (large boxes, etc.)
- □ If you are going to be conducting the drive outside, dress accordingly!
- ☐ If your team or group has uniforms or jackets, wear them during the drive. If you have a banner, bring it to the drive to represent your group!

Ongoing Drives in Local Stores, Library, Etc.

- □ Contact your local delis, convenience stores and libraries and request permission to place a donation box at their location.
- □ Decorate a large box with wrapping paper, leaving the top open to collect donations. Be sure to include information about the drive and what items you are collecting.
- ☐ Arrange a date and time when you will be picking up the box.
